



HER FAITH MINISTRIES, INC., is committed to assisting women with young children in gaining and/or regaining self-sufficiency by providing families with safe, clean, and affordable temporary housing in a communal setting.

Who qualifies?

We recognize that the need for temporary housing is great. However, HER Faith Ministries has committed its resources to serving young mothers who can benefit from ministry-subsidized housing until such time as they are able to gain self-sufficiency for themselves and their children. Mothers with one or two children may be considered for placement in ministry-supported housing.



How do families share the home?

The ministry house offers accommodations such that residents have their own sleeping quarters. However, all families share the sitting area, bathroom, and kitchen facilities.

Do rules exist for families living in ministry-supported housing?

For the safety and comfort of all residents, the ministry must apply and enforce consistent rules regarding: 1) who may occupy or visit the premises; 2) acceptable conduct and activities within ministry housing; 3) safety and security of residents. The ministry must exercise a ‘zero-tolerance’ policy with regard to adherence to rules and regulations.



Is there a curfew?

All residents are free to enter and leave the premises whenever they choose. However, the inside locks will be placed on doors at 10:00 p.m. (Persons working evening hours will need to make special arrangements).

How long will a family be permitted to live in ministry-subsidized housing?

Our ministry intends to provide temporary assistance for a period that would reasonably allow progress toward gainful employment and safe, permanent housing. We would expect to see consistent progress toward these goals over a period of six months. The circumstances for each resident will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

Do residents pay rent or utilities?

No. However, residents are expected to seek and secure employment such that they will help to offset the cost of housing.





Are pets allowed in ministry housing?

No. For the safety, health and security of our residents, no pets of any kind are allowed on ministry property.

Am I allowed to have visitors?

Again, for the safety, security and comfort of all ministry house residents, no visitors are allowed in the ministry house.

May I bring my own furniture?

The ministry house is fully furnished. Residents are not permitted to bring furniture or appliances into the house without the approval of the ministry.

What other amenities does the Ministry provide for residents?

Every situation differs. Therefore, the Ministry's response would be determined by the circumstances of the prospect resident. For totally impoverished individuals with few resources, the ministry may provide emergency food, bedding (for use in the ministry house), clothing, and other household items (cookware, etc.).

How is ministry housing funded?

The cost of housing is funded through special events and private donations from supporters and friends.
